GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE

The fund is a one-off for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring-fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support 16 to 19 students in **English, Maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted**. Although the actual tuition does not need to be for GCSE English or Mathematics, the students supported all need to be those who had not achieved grade 4 or above in at least one of those subjects at this level by age 16.

AMOUNT FOR KINGSBURY HIGH SCHOOL POST 16 PROVISION

Kingsbury High School is eligible to receive £9,567 from this fund for small group tuition.

TARGET GROUPS

- GCSE English retake students with 3 or less
- GCSE Maths retake students with 3 or less
- Post 16 students identified with challenges and gaps due to extended school closure

HOW WILL THE FUND BE DIRECTED AT KINGSBURY HIGH SCHOOL SIXTH FORM?

GCSE English retake students in Year 12 and 13 (grade 3 or below)

Intense 1-2-1 tuition between 2-5 times a week per student for one hour per session. Series of 3-hour 1-2-1 tutor sessions on site over half term and subsequent holiday periods prior to external exam.	£3200	9 passed grades 4-7. 11 failed grades 2-3.
