REWARDS

Assistant Headteacher organises

R3 HEADTEACHER'S GOLD NOTE

End of year recognition of students who have exemplified the PRIDE values across the academic year.

Stage Leader organises

R2 REWARDS ASSEMBLY

Half-termly recognition of achievements in attendance, punctuality and effort.

Teacher

R1 PRAISE POSTCARDS

Half-termly recognition of students who exemplify PRIDE values.

Teacher

IMMEDIATE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT STICKERS & STAMPS

Recognition of excellent effort in a lesson.

CONSEQUENCES

C3 EXCLUSION

May include an Internal Exclusion; Fixed Term Exclusion; Managed Move or Permanent Exclusion. This will be at the discretion of the Heads of School and Headteacher.

An exclusion for persistent poor behaviour may not take place without prior interventions which must include a parental meeting. Other interventions may include SEN reviews, student reports, mentoring, counselling and alternative provision.

Examples may include: failure to attend an SLT detention; aggressive/threatening behaviour; damage to property; bringing the school to disrepute; fighting; swearing in front of an adult; pattern of disruption; health & safety breach; smoking; bullying; sexism; religious discrimination; racism; homophobia; failed faculty review; swearing at an adult; physical assault on another student; smoking; theft; persistent disruption; posting offensive material electronically; failing the terms of the Internal Exclusion Room; possession of offensive weapons; serious physical assault on a student; possession/misuse/supplying drugs; physical assault on an adult; severe vandalism; continued persistent disruption after exhausting various interventions.

Year Leader completes an Exclusion Pack within 24 hours of the incident. Year Leader informs parents of the incident.

The Assistant Headteacher will consider sanctions up to internal exclusion level.

Fixed Term exclusions will be decided on by the Head of School.

The most serious behaviour incidents will be considered by the Headteacher.

C2 ON-CALL REFERRAL / DETENTION

AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION
3rd warning/referral from lesson; arrival after lesson start; eating/drinking in class; littering; incorrect uniform; misuse of electronic device; gambling; play-fighting; out of bounds; failure to bring PE kit

- 1 C2 in a day = 30 mins (15.30 - 16.00)
- 2 C2s in a day = 45 mins (15.30 - 16.15)
- 3 C2s in a day / missed lunchtime detention = 60 mins (15.30 - 16.30)

LUNCHTIME DETENTION
Late to school; uniform infraction = 20 mins (11.20-11.40 Yr7) (12.30-12.50 Yr8 & 9)

SLT DETENTION
Failure to attend detention; too many C2s in a day; truancy; failed teacher review
Mon / Tue / Thu - 90 mins (15.30 - 17.00)

Teacher logs C2; Year Leader schedules detention for the following day.

Parents are sent a text message to inform them.

C1 SECOND WARNING

Continued disruption to lesson.

CONCERN FIRST WARNING

Low-level infringement of KHS rules.
