Please read the following information:

- Your Attitude to Learning grade will be used to offer students a place in the Sixth Form.
- Your predicted GCSE grades will be used in reaching a decision about whether or not to make you a Provisional offer of the course/subjects you have chosen. Your results will be placed in your application form for you, after you hand it in. Your predicted grades are guided by your December trial examinations.
- All applicants will have a one-to-one interview in February 2019 to go through your choices. At the interview, you either be offered a firm place in the Sixth Form based on your current attitude to learning and predicted grades OR a provisional place based on improvement of your attitude to learning and grades.
- Students with Attitude to Learning score of 1.50 or less will receive a letter confirming they have a firm place in the Sixth Form – the Pathway will be determined by results as long as the subject entry criteria is met and you do not need to retake both GCSE English and Maths.
- Entry to the Sixth Form is based on your GCSE results meeting the entry criteria for your chosen Pathway AND achieving an average Attitude to Learning score of at least 'Good' in your Year 11 reports from your subject teachers. We reserve the right to withdraw offers/deny a place on the basis of your behaviour/attitude to learning throughout Year 11.
- Please note that we offer retake GCSE Maths or English but we do not offer both. If you need to retake both then you must choose a Level 2 (GCSE) course at a college or centre which offers Level 2. We only offer Level 3 A Levels and Btec Nationals. You will definitely need to retake with a 3 in Maths or English Language.
- Important - our entry criteria needs to be met to secure a place on your chosen course. Our decision in exercising judgement over the application of the entry criteria is final. Be aware that occasionally courses might not run if we fall below expected numbers at enrolment: though this is very rare indeed.
