## Introducing SAM Learning

At school we are always looking for ways to extend our pupils' learning. Part of our improvement programme involves the use of SAM Learning, a unique online service that offers multiple subjects. Studies show that pupils achieve 2 GCSE grades on average better than expected with as little as 10 hours or more use of SAM Learning.

## Access Details

All students in years 7 to 11 have been sent an email with their login details. I have also issued every student a task so they can get to know how the system works.

As well as tasks set by teachers students can self-select any subject at any level, for example a student could, if they need to, revise aspects of Primary School Literacy or Numeracy. Students can also look at some tasks of a GCSE subject they are thinking of taking in their Year 8 options.

## Getting Started

When students first log in they will be able to set up their own Avatar – which can be customised, as they complete challenges – as well as link with their friends to compete in challenges.
