I would like to congratulate you and your staff on your school's excellent achievement in entering 79 per cent of your pupils for a language GCSE in 2018.

The Government's view is that studying a language to GCSE is hugely important because the subject provides an opening to other cultures; fosters pupils' curiosity; deepens their understanding of the world; and equips them to study and work in other countries.
